IYNC- Innovation Contest

The purpose of I4N is to **reward innovative ideas focused on nuclear technologies or applications that will contribute to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.**

The contest will also give a platform for the visibility and discussion of these ideas and catalyze young energy into thinking about and creating innovative solutions.

Sustainable development goals are identified as following by the UN :



IYNC- Innovation Contest

I4N aims at being the world-wide competition of winners from national or regional nuclear innovation contests. Thus :

- IYNC engage with existing innovation contests from national YGN or other institutions in line with IYNC missions.
- IYNC support and promote the development of new national or regional nuclear innovation contests.
- All the winning teams from these local contests become participants for I4N, competing for the position of international winner during IYNC's Congress. IYNC will provide a travel grant to each team to attend the event.

The I4N contest is open to young professionals and students (up to and including 40 years old at the time of the IYNC Congress). There is no restriction on people's background (technical, economy, sociology, communication... and from academia, industry, regulatory...).

The language of the contest is English.



I4N : Contest Description


- Contestants will compete within their assigned category : (1) **technological** project or research (2) **organizational/societal** project or research.
- The presentation of the idea should be 15 minutes in duration, followed by 10 minutes of Q&A session, and based on the use of a PPT presentation or similar.
- The final winners will be chosen by a jury of experts of the nuclear industry, based on the following 4 evaluation criteria :
 1. **Presentation** (/6): Clarity, Interactivity, Presentation organization, Interaction with Audience and jury, Timing, Capability of answering questions.
 2. **Innovation contribution** (/4): Forward Thinking, Creativeness, Resolution of current problems and limitations
 3. **Applicability of idea** (/6): Possibility of bringing the idea to effective action by using various resources in an undefined time scale, Business plan proposal, Individuation of possible stakeholder interests, Depth of research, Quality of arguments and analyses
 4. **Contribution to sustainability** (/4): Contribution of the innovation to the sustainable goals as described by the UN.
- A finalist package will be given to all participants including certificate and I4N give away. Final winners will be awarded a special winning prize.


