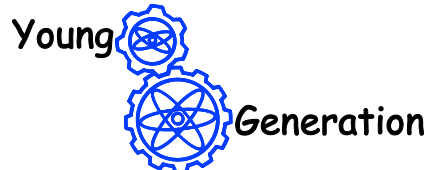


Nuclear Outlook - Finland

- Four running units
 - 2 x 880 MW in Olkiluoto (TVO)
 - 2 x 496 MW in Loviisa (Fortum)
- EPR under construction (1600 MW)
- Decision in Principle by the Finnish Parliament in 2010 for Fennovoima and TVO to build two additional reactors (3300-3600 MW in total)
- Strong support to nuclear power from Finnish public and politicians

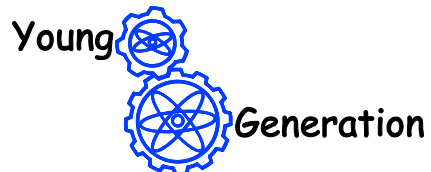


Activities - Finland
