Basic Facts - Sweden

- currently ca. 60 active members; 19 years of YG in Sweden results in hundreds of alumni
- 10 board members: 8 representing Swedish membership companies + 2 representing other companies and universities
- Westinghouse Sweden AB (main); Vattenfall; power stations: OKG, FKA, Ringhals; SKB; KSU; Studsvik



Nuclear Outlook - Sweden

- Vattenfall seriously considers new-build and SSM (rad. saf. authority) is proving legal status
- SKB and the state decided on location for nuclear waste final repository in Östhammar (Forsmark)
- public opinion relatively well balanced; political point of view seems to be rather vague
- higher education programs within nuclear engineering available at KTH, Chalmers and Uppsala University



Activities - Sweden

- Jan., annually: 2-day inauguration seminar for new generation of YG participants (20th anniversary in 2014) combined with final seminar of previous YG-generation
- fall, annually: 2-day mid-seminar for working group meetings and study visits with possibility for alumni to participate
