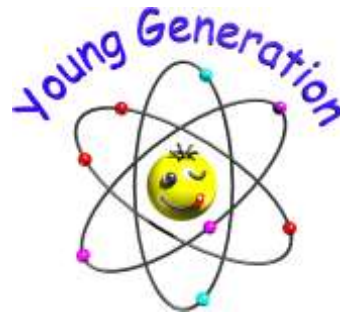

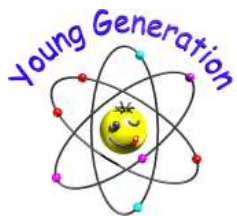

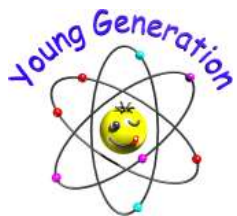
# Basic Facts - Switzerland

# Nuclear Outlook - Switzerland

- Switzerland has 5 nuclear reactors generating 40% of its electricity (all plants are owned by the state)
- In May 2011, the Swiss government decided to abandon plans to build new nuclear reactors. The existing reactors will be allowed to continue operations, but will not be replaced at the end of their life span. The last will go offline in 2034.
- This decision has to be confirmed by a public vote (pending)
- Extensive public discussion about possible substitutions

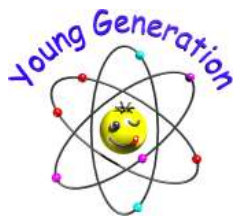
