

IYNC grant program general criteria

These grants are designed to help support the local or regional YGN and to increase members participation to their local YGN networks and in the IYNC network. These grants include international project grant, national project grant and regional event grant, characteristic of the different grants are available <http://www.iync.org/grants/>.

Activities must be in line with IYNC mission:

- Develop new approaches to communicate benefits of nuclear power, as part of a balanced energy mix;
- Promote further peaceful uses of nuclear science and technology for the welfare of mankind;
- Transfer knowledge from the current generation of leading scientists to the next generation and across international boundaries

Prospective applicants must fill out the required form, which details why a grant is being requested (available on IYNC website), remember these grants are designed to increase members participation in local and international YGN networks.

The IYNC grant committee will review the applications and determine recipients based on budget availability and following criteria. List of committee members is available on IYNC website.

Application must be sent at least two months before the schedule event date. Recipients will be reimbursed within 1 month after the proposed fund event has taken place, via wire transfer or PayPal transfer.

Applicants may contact grants@iync.org for information on the grant program and on the forms.

Criteria

Number of grants: is agreed in advanced with the BoD based on IYNC budget availability and current business plan.

Max amount: Maximum amount differs for the different event category. The different amounts are available on <http://www.iync.org/grants/>. Grants can also be awarded partially (not to the maximum amount available), such decision can be made by the committee based on the application proposal.

Category of Grant: Available on <http://www.iync.org/grants/>. In case of doubts, please contact grants@iync.org.

Grant committee resolution: decided by the grant committee, 2 months after application. In doubt, if the applicant wants to know the status of their application, please contact grants@iync.org The grant committee will evaluate the applications based on the parameters presented in the “Evaluating Criteria” section, and for each parameters point will be rewarded, as a guide to the decision.

Applicants are encouraged to provide letter(s) of recommendation from peers or advisor as a testimony to the requested information and importance of the event.

Please confirm the acceptance of the awarded grant within 2 weeks from receiving email communication by answering to grants@iync.org.

Evaluating Criteria:

1. Increase to YGN members and/or IYNC participants: No, YGN, YGN and IYNC: 0, 5, 10.
2. The event supports the IYNC mission statements: No, 1 mission, 2+ missions: 0, 5, 10.
3. Support to developing countries: G20 and OECD (Lists in Appendix-1), Rest of the world: 0, 10
4. Applicant previously awarded an IYNC Grant: Granted, Not granted: 0, 10
5. Visibility of IYNC to the event: None, Sponsoring material, Presentation, Plenary session: 0, 5, 7, 10
6. Audience of the event: Local, National, International: 0, 5, 10.
7. Other sponsors/supporter: up to 10 points.
8. Innovation contest during the event: No, Yes: 0, 5. This is a new parameter added as in line to the new activities proposed for the 2016-2018 mandate.
